



«LEGALframeWORK - Work and Legality in the Society of Inclusion» (code 2010TLKHKP) is one of the 14 National Research Projects (PRIN) funded by the Ministry of University for the entire legal area in 2012. It is a three-year-long project (2013-2015), which involves 11 Italian universities as well as the partnership of 24 European universities (Bordeaux, Bucharest, Castilla-La Mancha, Halle-Wittenberg, Louvain, Innsbruck, Madrid, Paris, Rijeka, Silesia, Sevilla, Trier, Valencia, Wien). The defining features of the project are clarified by the title itself: the link between work, legality and social inclusion, on the one hand; the key importance of the rules considered as constituting the «framework» in the traditional conception of labour law studies, namely the instruments aimed at supporting the functioning and effectiveness of substantive law, on the other hand. The reconstruction of the systems of rules in force, to be carried out in the first year, shall be integrated in the second year, with the empirical analysis of further socio-economical, case-law, contractual data, in order to foster, in the third year, the elaboration of proposals, operative instruments, guide-lines, regulatory projects. In the current times, when the respect of legality is again a crucial value for political and social choices (for example, concerning the fights against mafias and tax evasion), focusing on work and its rules becomes more and more necessary. In fact, the frequent reforms could jeopardise the effectiveness of rules and the target of social inclusion. The project aims at examining some of the innumerable aspects of the fight against the irregularity of work and in the work, of the promotion of regular work, not only from a theoretical perspective but also from an action/practical one, in order to elaborate guidelines that can be useful to all the actors involved.
